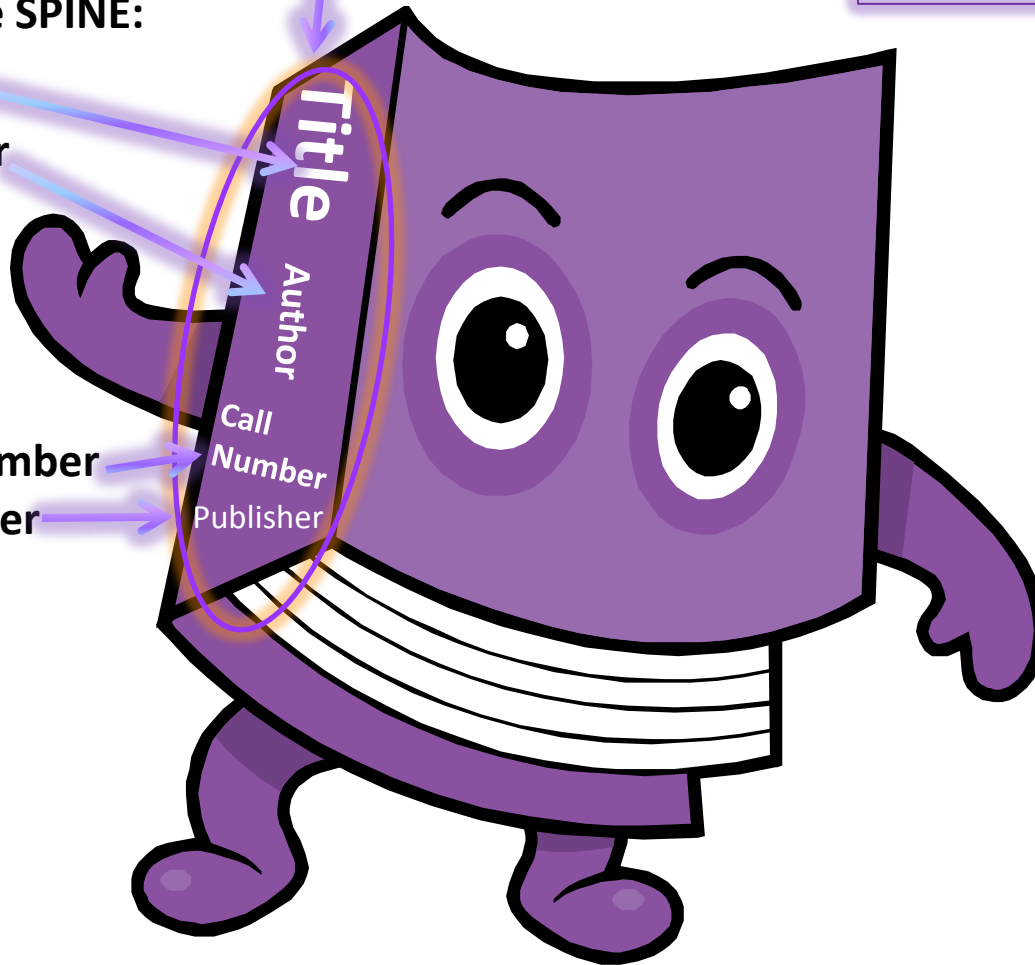

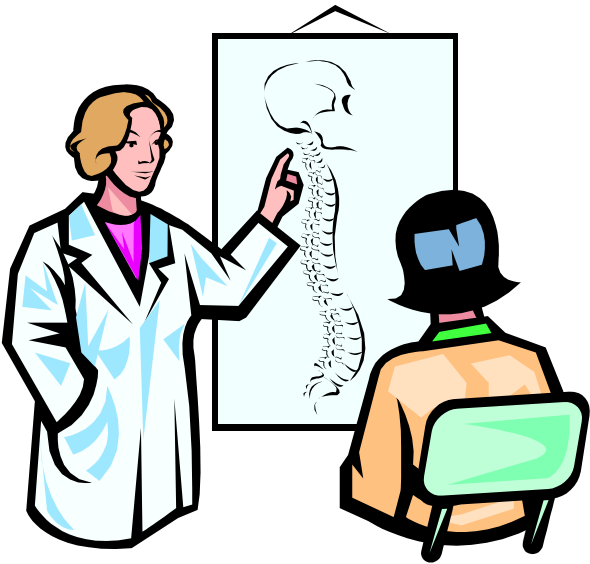
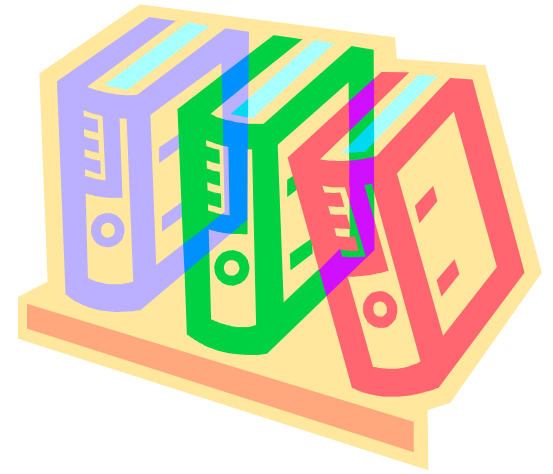

The Spine of a book holds it together.



The spine of a book is the part that you see when the book is on the shelf, and other books are along side your book.



The spine of a book helps hold your book together and keep it strong just like the spine in your body does!



THE SPINE ON A BOOK WILL HAVE...

Title

This is the name of the book.

Author

This is the name of the person who wrote the book.

Author

Call Number

This number tells you where the book can be found in the library.

Publishing Company

This is the company that makes the book after it has been written and illustrated.

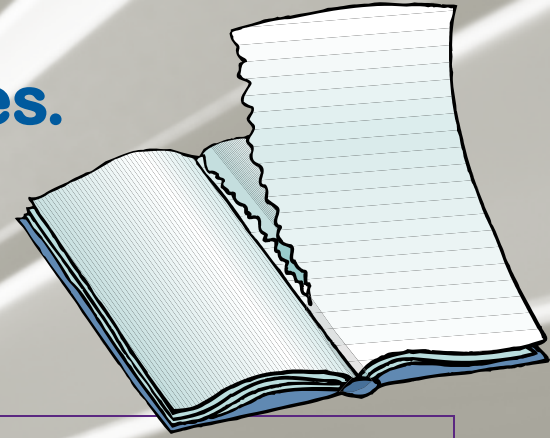


The call number tells you where to find the book in the library.

It may have numbers or letters. It may even have both numbers and letters.



The **COVER** of the book protects the pages.



On a **COVER**

Title

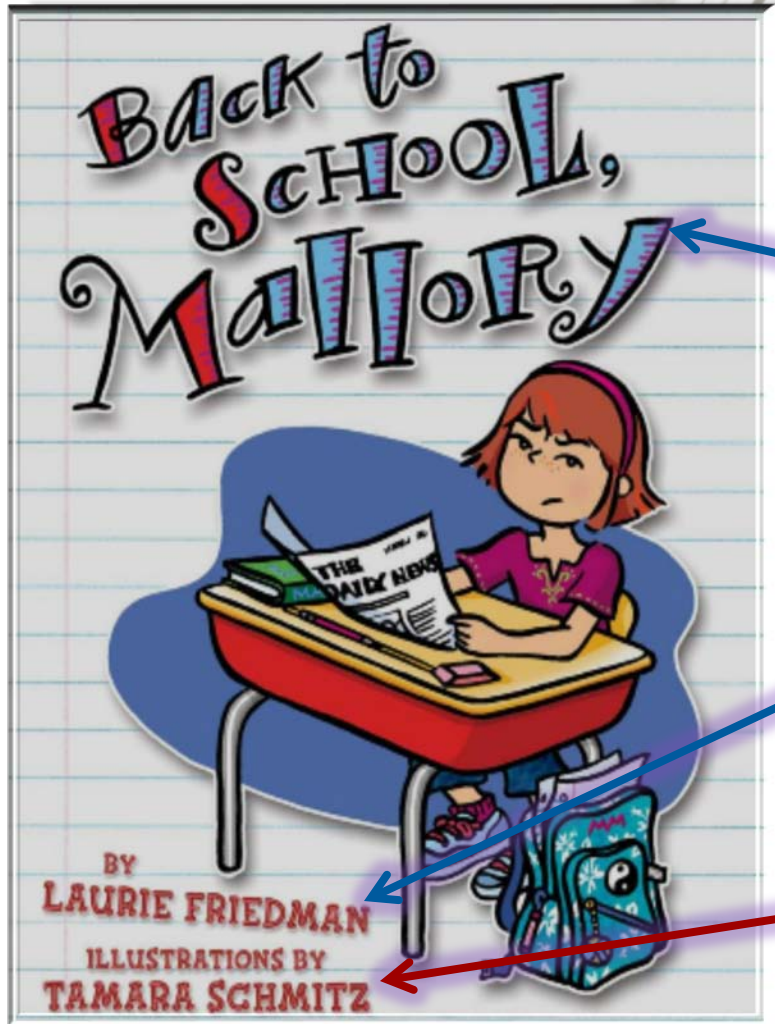
This is the name of the book.

Author

This is the person who wrote the book.

Illustrator

This is the person who drew the illustrations or pictures.



The TITLE PAGE is the first page in the book.
