After consulting with the administration at RHS, in an effort to control the spread of COVID-19 at Roswell High School, and to prevent a mandatory shut down on the fourth rapid response, Roswell High School we will be voluntarily shutting from August 18th – August 27. Roswell High School will switch to virtual learning Wednesday August 18th at regular class time. Please be on the lookout for further direction from building Principal, Mr. Carrasco, as to times, dates and further Chromebook information. Roswell High School will re-open for in-person learning on Monday August 30th. This will give the staff and students at RHS 11 calendar days to hopefully have a COVID reset.

Because the closure was voluntary, sports, clubs, and activities will still be allowed to continue at RHS

Because this closure is a voluntary move to try and help control the spread of COVID-19 sports, clubs, and activities will still be allowed to continue at RHS. Had this been a mandatory closure from the state no activities would have been allowed and students would have been out the full 14 days. It is extremely important that students and coaches be vigilant at this time. A spike in numbers for groups or teams will result in shutdowns for those programs and could increase the amount of time those students will not be in person for their education.

As a district we are working to explore every avenue that will give us as much interaction with our students as possible. We would ask everyone to practice social distancing as much as possible as we look forward to the return to in person learning at RHS.
